

Haitian Schools—How You Can Help!



In response to so many inquiries concerning the situation in Haiti, we would like to let you know about a few ways you can help. Haiti has always been a country with many needs, and now they need us—the body of Christ—more than ever. Everyone has seen the images coming out of Haiti. This earthquake has ravished the country, leaving thousands dead, and close to one million people homeless.

Prior to the earthquake, approximately 380,000 orphans lived in Haiti. Now we can only guess how many more there are. Ten schools using the A.C.E. program and curriculum (most of them are orphanages run by missionaries) function within Haiti.

We have been in touch with our Haitian A.C.E. Consultant who has run an orphanage of over 90 children for 15 years. Thankfully they have survived the earthquake without any damage, but they are dealing with the scarcity of fuel, water, and food as the staff assist others who lost everything.

We are still awaiting word on how the earthquake has affected the other schools, especially those located within Port au Prince. Those whose facilities have not been affected will be inundated with more children in need of care. We must pray that God will provide many opportunities for the truth of the Gospel to penetrate people's hearts through this tragedy.

How will A.C.E. help?

- We will offer to replace any previously purchased curriculum that has been damaged or lost.
- We plan to take the Service Adventure group to Haiti in June to help rebuild Learning Centers and student offices.
